Under the direction of J.D. Frizzell, OneVoice has quickly become a high-profile musical entity at Briarcrest Christian School, throughout the Mid-South, and around the United States. Performing popular music of many styles and periods, OneVoice incorporates blues, jazz, rock, R&B, pop, and more into their repertoire.

Annually, the ensemble records an album in one of the best studios in the region, The Grove. They have performed with GRAMMY Award winning vocal group New York Voices and professional a cappella group Overboard.

Their albums, produced by Dave Sperandio of diovoce studios and published by A Cappella Records, have won accolades and entertained fans worldwide. They can be found on iTunes, Loudr, Spotify, Pandora, and other online music stores. The Recorded A Cappella Review Board called their debut album Another Level "One of the best high school albums of all time...a wonderful recording achievement". The readers of the Commercial Appeal chose OneVoice as the "Best Unknown Band" in Memphis in 2013.
