## **Who we are**

OneVoice is a high school contemporary a cappella group, meaning that we sing with no instruments, using our voices to create a full vocal band. OneVoice has recorded award-winning albums, performed with GRAMMY award winning artists, appeared on America's Got Talent, and sung before tens of millions of people worldwide.

## **What we sing**

OneVoice sings a variety of popular music styles from various genres including top 40, rock, jazz, R & B, and more. Because our arrangements are complex and carefully constructed for our individual voices, we are rarely able to accommodate song requests unless they are already in our repertoire. ## **Concert Length**

Concerts can be anywhere from 20-60 minutes depending on the needs of the gig.

## **Minimum Fee**

With the exception of school-based outreach concerts, our minimum fee for a performance is \$1,500 USD. This includes any and all rehearsals, concert coordination, set up, and tear down. This fee is standard and in line with other performing groups of this level.

## **Sound Equipment**

If we are singing in a room larger than 20'x20', we require the use of sound equipment. We have our own sound system and prefer to use it at all times if possible. If we are performing in an auditorium or other venue with a built in sound system, here are our requirements for the mains and subs:

# ONE VOICE

A professional stereo high quality sound system capable of producing 100dBA at the mixing point of clean, undistorted full range sound with a flat frequency response between 20 and 20k hertz. Subwoofers are required.

We will connect our travel mixing board, wireless microphone system, and in ear monitor system to your preexisting setup.

All technical details should be arranged in detail at least 30 days prior to the event.

## **Stage Area**

We need a minimum stage space of 25' wide and 20' deep.

## **Merchandise Sales**

We request the right to sell merchandise including but not limited to CDs, download cards, and t-shirts. We will provide the people to staff the merchandise table. A suitable and prominent space is required for the selling of merchandise (CDs, sheet music etc.). This area should be in the entrance hall or foyer and consist of:

- a. One table for venues less than 600 capacity
- b. Two tables for venues greater than 600 capacity

If your venue requires a split of merchandise sales, please notify Spencer Stewart at least 30 days prior to the event. OneVoice is happy to sign CDs and t-shirts after the concert. Please let us know if you would like us to do this.

## **Rehearsal**

We need an on-mic rehearsal in the performance space without distraction for at least 45 minutes.

## **Dressing Rooms**

A minimum of one clean lockable dressing room or holding room is requested. Two are preferred.

Please provide bottled water at the side of the stage during the performance and in the dressing room.

## **Food**

If the event is between 11 AM and 2:00 PM, we kindly request that you provide lunch. If it is after 5:00 PM, we kindly request that you provide dinner. One member of the group cannot eat gluten.
